2. The owner undertaking immediate remedial measures should a noise/smoke/odour nuisance arise.
3. Restricted against the smoking of tobacco products as a designated smoking area, in terms of the Tobacco Control Regulations has not been provided.

4. The premises, including the refuse bin area and the refuse bins must be maintained in a neat and tidy condition at all times.
5. No playing of any live music or karaoke or any amplified music that may cause a disturbance to the neighbourhood.
6. The premises must be kept free of flies, cockroaches, rodents, birds and other pests. In this regard a valid pest control certificate from an approved / registered pest control must be provided to the department
7. All products must be obtained from approved/registered sources only.
8. This department reserves the right to call for additional health requirements, should the need arise.
