CONCEPT DESIGN AND HIGH LEVEL ESTIMATE COSTING FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY AND RAIN WATER HARVESTING

1. Background

The Durban ICC is one of the world's leading events and meetings destinations. In order to maintain the extremely high international standards as a facility it is important that we have the correct infrastructure ensuring our operations run optimally.

2. Purpose

The Durban ICC requires a consulting engineer to scope, design and provide high level cost estimation for the alternative water supply and conceptualise rain water harvesting for all three (3) sections of the Durban ICC (ICC, Arena and DEC).

- Prepare concept design for the rain harvesting system for all three (3) sections of the Durban ICC, namely: ICC, Arena and DEC
- Prepare concept for the use of the harvested water for irrigation and ablution facilities
- Prepare high level cost estimate for the complete projects
- Incorporate feedback and revise concept drawings and cost estimate
- Prepare final concept document and high level cost estimate





