

RE-ADVERTISEMENT: REQUEST FOR QUOTATION – BQ 16/2021

SERVICING AND MAINTENANCE OF AIR-CONDITIONING COOLING TOWERS WATER TREATMENT SYSTEM AT THE DURBAN ICC COMPLEX FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS

1. Background

The Durban ICC Complex is one of the world's leading events and meetings destinations that comprises of ICC, Arena and Durban Exhibition Centre. In order to maintain the extremely high international standards, all the equipment at the facility need to be maintained at international standards in compliance with Occupational Health and Safety regulations.

2. Purpose

The Durban ICC requires a suitable contractor to provide servicing and maintenance of air-conditioning cooling towers water treatment system at the Durban ICC Complex for a period of 12 months.

NB: The service provider will only conduct service and maintenance three days in a week.

• The company must provide proof of compulsory insurance as well as public liability insurance to a minimum value of R20 Million.		
• Prospective service provider must employ competent and experienced (minimum 3 years) staff with water treatment qualifications/competencies, or similar. Please attach a 2 page CV detailing work experience of the individuals who will be on site.		
• The prospective service provider must have access to all special tools required for providing water treatment services.		
• The prospective service provider must submit the maintenance schedule outlining the methodology to be used and frequency of maintenance.		

Please Note: Failure to meet all of the stipulated mandatory requirements will result in the service provider being deemed non-responsive and will not be considered for evaluation. The bidder must complete the final column above stating whether they can complete the task or not.

4. Mandatory Scope of Work

4.1 Water treatment specification for general HVAC Systems.

Summary

- Provide complete chemical water treatment for the systems as listed in this document.
- Provide chemicals as required to control scale, corrosion, biological fouling and biological foaming.

Quality Assurance

- The service provider for water treatment chemical and service shall be a recognised specialist, active in the field of Industrial water treatment for the last ten (10) years, whose major business is in the field of water treatment.
- The service provider must have water analysis laboratories, development facilities and a service department as well as full time service personnel located within the geographical area of the Durban ICC.

Record Documents

- Water analysis – The service provider must submit a copy of the water analysis to illustrate water quality available at each of the treatment areas.
- Field Test Reports – The service provider shall indicate and interpret results for compliance with performance requirements.

4.2 Products

General

- Introduce chemicals treatment through bypass feeder when required or indicated by test.
- Open Loop System – Condenser Water Piping: Pump sequestering agent and corrosion inhibitor from the solution tank into the condenser water supply to the cooling towers.
 - Intermittently feed biocide to condenser water to achieve a toxic level of the chemical, to kill the organisms present.
 - Activate chemical solution pump via the water meter which is connected via the make-up water line to the cooling tower when condenser water pumps are running.
- Closed Loop System – Chilled Water Piping: Supply corrosion inhibitor and biocides to chilled water to achieve a toxic level of chemicals to kill the organisms present and prevent corrosion. Ensure chemical levels are correct at all times.

4.3 Performance requirements:

- Maintain water quality for HVAC systems that controls corrosion and build-up of scale and biological growth for maximum efficiency of installed equipment without posing a hazard to operating personnel or the environment.
- Base chemical treatment performance requirements on the quality of water at the Durban ICC, the HVAC equipment materials and the operating requirements of the maintenance personnel.
 - Conductivity: 1500-1600 mmho (1500 – 1650 umho)
 - Acceptable PH: Not less than 8 or greater than 9.5

4.4 Chemical Treatment Test Equipment

- **Test Kit:** Manufacturer recommended equipment and chemicals, in a carrying case, for testing PH, total dissolved solids, bio-count, chloride, and total alkalinity and for calcium hardness field tests.

- **Corrosion Test Coupon Assembly:** Constructed of corrosion material, complete with piping, valves and mild steel and copper coupons. Locate copper coupon downstream from mild steel coupon in the test coupon assembly.
- Four station rack for open condenser water systems.

4.5 Chemicals

- **Biocides:** Chlorine release agents or microbicides.
- **Open-loop Condenser Water Piping Chemicals:** Sequestering agent to inhibit scaling, acid to reduce alkalinity and PH, corrosion inhibitor and biocide.

4.6 Required frequency of maintenance

- Frequency of service calls - Monthly
- Frequency of water analysis - Monthly
- Frequency of Legionella Testing - Bi-annually
- Frequency of special analysis - On request
