SERVICE AND REPAIR OF GREASE TRAP AT THE DURBAN ICC (ONCE OFF)

1. Background

The Durban ICC is one of the world's leading events and meetings destinations. In order to maintain the extremely high international standards as a facility it is important that we have the correct infrastructure in the various areas so that our operations run optimally thereby ensuring effective client service

2. Purpose

The Durban ICC requires an experienced service provider to provide a "once-off" service and repair to the grease trap located within the Durban ICC facility.

4. Mandatory scope of work

The service provider must:

- Supply chemicals for cleaning and removal of grime and sludge
- High pressure clean the entire system, including the walls, pipes, baskets, basket hatch covers, steel grids, etc. using their own equipment
- Pump out the sludge and remove all waste from the grease trap and safely dispose off-site.
- Repair all equipment such as baskets, basket hatch covers, grids, pipes, etc. once cleaned and exposed.
- Supply missing equipment such as basket hatch covers, etc. where applicable at a maximum mark-up of 7% on spares.

5. Conditions of the contract

- 5.1 It must be noted that the service provider assumes full risk when submitting bid proposals to the Durban ICC.
- 5.2 All work to be carried out / material to be used / techniques performed according to professional standards / practice / industry norm.
- 5.3 Any additional work that is not included in the initial scope will have to be quoted for on 'material-and-labour' basis.
- 5.4 The additional work must be approved by the Durban ICC prior to proceeding. This may be necessary if severe damages are found on the baskets and pipes during the pressure cleaning of the grease trap system.
- 5.5 The Durban ICC is not obligated to the appointed service provider to undertake the additional work identified and reserves the right to test the market in order to obtain value for money.
- 5.6 The mark-up on spares are limited to a maximum of 7%
- 5.7 The appointed service provider must furnish work insurance cover to a minimum value of one million rand, prior to commencement of contract.
- 5.8 A written workmanship warranty of minimum 12 months is required.

6. Preconditions

A written proposal/quotation will not be considered unless the service provider who submits the quotation provides the following with their proposal/quotation:

- 6.1 Full name
- 6.2 Identification or company or other registration number
- 6.3 Tax reference number and VAT number, if any
- 6.4 Valid original Tax clearance from South African Revenue Services which proves that the Provider's tax matters are in order
- 6.5 Valid BBBEE Certificate
- 6.6 MBD 4 Declaration of Interest form must be completed
- 6.7 The service provider must be registered on the CSD database and EThekweni Vendor Portal. Proof of registration needs to be submitted. Failure to be registered on these databases will adversely affect the awarding process and may result in the service provider being deemed non-responsive.





