



RE-ADVERTISEMENT: REQUEST FOR QUOTATION: BS 09/2022

SUPPLY OF DIESEL FOR THE STANDBY GENERATORS AT THE DURBAN ICC COMPLEX FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS

1. Background

The Durban ICC Complex is one of the most advanced and leading events and meetings destination that comprises of the ICC, Arena and Durban Exhibition Centre (DEC). In order to maintain the extremely high international standards, all the equipment at the facility must be available and uninterrupted at all times, even unplanned power outages caused by unplanned breakdown and/or load shedding.

2. Purpose of the request for proposal

The Durban ICC requires a suitable service provider that will supply low sulphur diesel to all six (6) standby generators at the Durban ICC Complex on an ad-hoc basis, as and when required.

4. Conditions of contract

- Before diesel can be supplied, the prospective service provider must provide health and safety file and a risk register for safe transportation and handling of flammable liquids.
- The service provider must be able to deliver the requested quantity of diesel to Durban ICC, Arena and Durban Exhibition Centre within four (4) hours on receipt of an official telephonic and/or e-mail request.
- The prospective service provider must ensure that the vehicle that is used for delivery of diesel at Durban ICC and Arena is not more than 2 meters high as this is the height restriction for accessing Substations 2, 3 and 4.



- The vehicle transporting diesel must be fitted with appropriate pipes and pumps that will be used for pumping diesel from the transportation tank to the respective diesel generator tanks.
- The proposed mark-up percentage (%) will be fixed for a period of 12 months

5. Preconditions

A written proposal/quotation will not be considered unless the service provider who submits the quotation provides the following with their proposal/quotation:

- 5.1 Full name
- 5.2 Identification or company or other registration number
- 5.3 Tax reference number and VAT number, if any
- 5.4 Valid compliance report, confirming compliance at time of bid submission,
- 5.5 Valid BBBEE Certificate
- 5.6 Valid SARS tax clearance pin.
- 5.7 Confirmation of registration on eThekweni Municipality's vendor portal database.
- 5.8 MBD 4 Declaration of Interest form must be completed
- 5.9 Statement that the company's water, electricity and rates are up to date or formal payment arrangements have been made.

6. Terms and Conditions

- It must be noted that the service provider assumes full risk when submitting bid proposals to the Durban ICC.
- The Durban ICC reserves the right at its discretion to rescind a contract, based on the needs of the entity.
- The entity will only make a final award should the bidder be tax compliant at time of award.

7 Requirements to submit quotation

- 7.1 All schedules in this document must be populated and will form part of the quotation.
- 7.2 Companies must submit a company profile and are to provide examples and references of similar work performed.
- 7.3 A contactable e-mail address and/or business card must be provided together with all written proposals/quotations.



7.4 The service provider must be registered on the CSD database as well as the eThekweni Municipality vendor portal database. Proof of registration on these two databases must be included together with the bid submission. Failure to register on these two databases may adversely impact on the award process.


