



**REQUEST FOR QUOTATION – IT 23/2022**

**SUPPLY OF INTERNET CONNECTIVITY FOR THE DURBAN ICC (Wi-Fi)  
FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS**

**1. Background**

The Durban ICC is one of the world's leading events and meetings destinations. In order to maintain the extremely high international standards as a facility it is important that we have the correct infrastructure in the various areas so that our operations run optimally thereby ensuring efficient client service.

The business currently uses a combination of dedicated fibre optic bandwidth connectivity as well as ADSL for the provision of internet services to both the Durban ICC internal network and client Wi-Fi network.

**2. Purpose**

The Durban ICC requires the services of an internet service provider (registered with ICASA) for the supply of internet connectivity, for a period of 12 months.



