**1. Background**


The Durban International Convention Centre (Durban ICC) is a premier conference and event venue located in Durban, South Africa. As a leading facility, the Durban ICC is committed to maintaining a robust and efficient Information and Communication Technology (ICT) infrastructure. To ensure the continued excellence and reliability of our services, we are seeking a comprehensive condition assessment of our entire ICT landscape.

**2. Purpose**

The purpose of this RFQ is to solicit quotations from qualified professionals to conduct a thorough assessment of the Durban ICC's ICT infrastructure. The goal is to identify current conditions, potential risks, and areas for improvement to enhance the performance, security, and reliability of our ICT systems. This will assist in planning for future upgrades and maintaining the Durban ICC's status as a leading convention centre.

Where:

$P_s$  = Points scored for price of tender under consideration


$P_t$  = Price of tender under consideration

$P_{min}$  = Price of lowest acceptable tender

#### 4.0 POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1 In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the request for tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the **points claimed** for the goal(s) stated in **Table 1** below, as supported by proof submitted.
- 4.2 In cases where the municipality intends to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, the municipality must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of:
- (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system, or
  - (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,
- then the municipality must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.
