1. Background

The Durban ICC is one of the most advanced conferencing facilities in the world. The Centre has an Integrated Management System with which consists of certification for ISO 14001 (Environmental Management), ISO 22000 (Food Safety Management), ISO 9001 (Quality Management) and 45001 (Occupational Health and Safety Management System) which has to be maintained and continually improved in order to retain these high standards which are audited annually by the SABS (South African Bureau of Standards).

2. Legislation

This quotation will be evaluated on administrative compliance, mandatory requirements, price and preference points in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (No 5 of 2000) and Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2022 where 80/20 points system will be applied wherein 80 points are for price and 20 for specific goals and for this purpose the enclosed forms must be scrutinized, completed and submitted together with your detailed quotation/proposal .

3. Purpose

The Durban ICC requires the services of a duly experienced waste recycling contractor/ service provider complying with applicable legislation, regulations and/or standards of practice. This service will consist of waste separation, sorting, weighing and recycling with the inclusion staffing for the Durban ICC and Durban Exhibition Centre (DEC) for a period of 12 months.

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5. Two Stage evaluation process

Stage 2: Price and Preference

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenderer is **PRICE AND PREFERENCE** in accordance with the Entity's current SCM Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (5 of 2000), and the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act Regulations (2022).

The **80/20** preference points system will be applied. The Formula used to calculate the **Price Points (max. 80)** will be according to that specified Regulation 4.1.

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6. Scope of Supply /Services

- 6.1 Durban ICC is SABS ISO 14001 (Environmental Management Systems) certified and in-line with keeping up with international standards and ensuring environmental sustainability, an experienced waste recycling contractor/ service provider with traceable references is required to provide recycling services for the Durban ICC.
- 6.2 Service Provider shall render professional services to the Durban ICC.
- 6.3 Due to the physically strenuous nature of certain recycling and waste handling activities, the Service Provider shall ensure that a suitably capable and adequately resourced workforce is deployed to execute the services safely, efficiently, and in compliance with applicable occupational health and safety and environmental legislation.
- 6.4 The Service Provider will be required to work from 07h30am – 17h00pm, Monday to Sunday which may be event dependant. The Service Provider may be requested to provide ad hoc services which will be subject the Durban ICC SCM process.
- 6.5 The Service Provider must separate, sort, weigh and recycle all waste from the Durban ICC and Durban Exhibition Centre (DEC) as required by the Durban ICC.
- 6.6 The Service Provider must recycle all materials listed below:
- 6.6.1 Paper;
 - 6.6.2 Glass;
 - 6.6.3 Cardboard;
 - 6.6.4 Cans;
 - 6.6.5 PET (Polyethylene terephthalate) - Hard Plastic;
 - 6.6.6 Polystyrene;
 - 6.6.7 Mixed plastic;
 - 6.6.8 Cardboard Cores; and
 - 6.6.9 Other materials
- 6.7 The service provider and its staff must:
- 6.7.1 Provide sorting frame with hessian bags and tarp for the recycle materials as per point 6.6.
 - 6.7.2 Provide quantified monthly reports for all recycled waste for both the Durban ICC and DEC sites and a combined total for both sites,
 - 6.7.3 Provide quantified ad hoc reports for all recycled waste for both the Durban ICC and DEC sites for certain events, as requested by the Durban ICC;
 - 6.7.4 At all times comply with the National Environmental Management Act, 107 of 1998 and ISO 14001 (Environmental Management System).
 - 6.7.5 Comply with all Durban ICC Safety, Health and Environmental policies and regulations;
 - 6.7.6 Ensure recycling areas and bins are cleaned up thoroughly at the end of the shift with approved cleaning chemicals, as per point 6.7.7 and 6.8 below;
 - 6.7.7 Ensure they have a hosepipe to be used for cleaning.
- 6.8 The service provider must provide cleaning chemicals listed with a 16-point format Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 6.9 The Service provider must for the duration of this agreement have a valid licence for waste removal and recycling as issued by the Department of Environmental Affairs or an accredited third party recycler. The Service Provider must provide proof of certification to the Durban ICC for the duration of this agreement, as and when requested by the Durban ICC.

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- 6.10 The Service provider must at all times for the duration of this contract be in possession of a:
- 6.9.1 Valid eThekweni Municipality schedule trade permit for waste removal and recycling; and
 - 6.9.2 Valid DSW transportation permit for waste removal and recycling.
 - 6.9.3 Valid Certificate of Registration with South African Waste Information System (SAWIS)
- 6.11 The Service provider must ensure that a calibrated Scale of 200kg minimum is utilised for the services. The Service Provider must be in possession of a certificate for the scale with information on scale, last date of calibration as well as next calibration date. If service provider utilises a third party recycler, a calibration certificate must be provided to the Durban ICC, as and when requested by the Durban ICC.
- 6.12 The Service Provider must co-operate with waste disposal requirements as required by the Durban Solid Waste (DSW).
- 6.13 The service provider shall provide adequate training to the Durban ICC's personnel whenever necessary.
- 6.14 The service provider shall provide audits to the Durban ICC, as and when required, and point out all deviation in the form of report to the Durban ICC.
- 6.15 The Service Provider must prepare a detailed service plan within 7 days after the SLA has been signed, which the Durban ICC shall review and acknowledge, and which shall form an integral part of the service agreement.

- 9.3 The service provider must have a safety file ready compiled and to be submitted to the Durban ICC soon after appointment.
- 9.4 The service provider and his staffing must comply with all Durban ICC Safety, Health and Environmental policies and regulations.
- 9.5 Hours of work are from 07h30am – 17h00pm, Mon – Sunday however this is event dependant and ad hoc services may be required.
- 9.6 The service provider must always ensure they comply with the National Environmental Management Act.
- 9.7 The service provider shall ensure all their waste and recycling licences and permits remain valid throughout the term of the contract and ensure they apply timeously to the respective government and municipal departments for new licences and permits.

- 1.4 Failure on the part of the bidder to submit the required proof or documentation, in terms of the requirements in the (Special) Conditions of Tender for claiming **Specific Goal** preference points, will be interpreted that preference points for **Specific Goals** are not claimed.
- 1.5 The Durban ICC reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before evaluation or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard of preferences, in any manner required by the entity.

2.0 DEFINITIONS

- 2.3 **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes.
- 2.4 **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by Municipality in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the Municipality and a third party that produces revenue for the Municipality, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions.
- 2.5 **“the Act”** means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the **points claimed** for the goal(s) stated in **Table 1** below, as supported by proof submitted.
- 4.2 In cases where the municipality intends to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, the municipality must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of:

 - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct.
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation.
 - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram partem* (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.

- ¹ Includes price quotations/ proposals , advertised competitive bids, limited bids and proposals.
- ² Bid rigging (or collusive bidding) occurs when businesses, that would otherwise be expected to compete, secretly conspire to raise prices or lower the quality of goods and / or services for purchasers who wish to acquire goods and / or services through a bidding process. Bid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors not to compete.
- ³ Joint venture or Consortium means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.
